COOKIE PRIVACY POLICY

This notice aims to explain what cookies are, which cookies are used on this website, and how visitors can make informed choices about their management.

This site uses cookies, including third-party cookies, to offer services and information aligned with users' expectations.

1. WHAT COOKIES ARE AND WHICH COOKIES THIS WEBSITE USES

Cookies are small strings of text that websites visited by users send to their terminals (usually browsers), where they are stored to be retransmitted to the same websites upon subsequent visits. While browsing a site, users may also receive cookies on their terminals from different sites or web servers (so-called "third parties"), which may contain elements (e.g., images, maps, sounds, specific links to other domains) present on the site being visited.

Cookies are often found in large numbers in users' browsers and may have long persistence periods. They serve various purposes, such as performing computer authentications, session tracking, and storing information on user-specific configurations for accessing the server.

To properly regulate these tools, it is necessary to distinguish them based on their purposes, as there are no technical characteristics that inherently differentiate them. According to the EU directive 2009/136/EC and Italian legislation (Legislative Decree 69/2012), the installation of cookies for non-technical purposes requires the user's prior informed consent.

In this regard, two main categories of cookies are identified: "technical" cookies and "profiling" cookies.

a. Technical Cookies

This website uses first-party technical cookies (session cookies, functionality/persistent cookies, and, in some cases, aggregated and anonymized analytics cookies), and potentially third-party technical cookies.

Technical cookies are used solely to:

"carry out the transmission of a communication over an electronic communications network, or as strictly necessary to provide an information society service explicitly requested by the subscriber or user."

These cookies are not used for further purposes and are usually installed directly by the website owner or operator. They can be divided into:

 Browsing or session cookies, which ensure normal navigation and use of the website (e.g., enabling purchases or log-ins to reserved areas);

- Analytics cookies, treated as technical cookies when used directly by the website operator to
 collect aggregate and anonymous data about the number of users and their interaction with
 the website;
- **Functionality cookies**, which allow users to navigate according to selected criteria (e.g., language, selected products) to improve the service provided.

These cookies do not require prior user consent. However, site managers must provide this information as per Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR). Blocking technical cookies may impact your ability to access and fully use the website.

Legal basis: The use of technical cookies is considered a legitimate interest of the Data Controller.

b. Profiling Cookies

This website does not use first-party profiling cookies but may use third-party profiling cookies.

Profiling cookies are designed to create user profiles and deliver targeted advertising based on the user's browsing habits. Given their potentially intrusive nature, users must be clearly informed and give valid consent before these cookies are installed.

Storage of or access to information on the user's device is only permitted after obtaining consent. You can block the installation of third-party profiling cookies as explained in section 3.

Third Parties Involved: Publishers and "Third Parties"

Another key factor is identifying whether the cookies are set by the same website the user is visiting (referred to as the "publisher") or by another website ("third parties").

According to official guidance, third-party cookie responsibilities fall on the third parties, but the site owner acts as a technical intermediary and must include links to the third-party cookie policies and consent forms in the extended policy.

2. WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING COOKIE INFORMATION AND COLLECTING CONSENT?

According to FAQs published by the Italian Data Protection Authority (Garante per la protezione dei dati personali), the following are responsible:

- **The website owner**, if they install profiling cookies. (Note: This website does **not** use first-party profiling cookies.)
- **Third parties**, if their cookies are used via the website. The website owner must provide links to third-party policies and consent tools.
